

1. US CENSUS BUREAU INTERNATIONAL DATABASE UPDATE. IDB updated its database on Jun. 18, 2008. Of particular interest to researchers in aging might be the fact that: "In order to better project countries with increasing numbers of people in the oldest ages, [the IDB is] in the process of converting [its] projections to be done by single years of age up to 100 years and over." This change was done for the following 5 countries: Central African Republic, Pakistan, St. Kitts and Nevis, Saudi Arabia, and British Virgin Islands.
